
In accordance with the authority granted to me (pursuant to the Delegations and Appointment memorandum of October 24th, 2010) as the Senior Procurement Executive, U.S. Department of Transportation (Department), I hereby delegate authority to the Director, Acquisition and Contracting, Federal Aviation Administration to enter into Energy Savings Performance Contracts (ESPCs), through the Department of Energy's Federal Energy Management Program (FEMP), on behalf of the Department. This delegation is issued under the terms and conditions outlined below:

1. The contracts entered into under this delegation are those relating to Energy Savings Performance Contracts (ESPCs) and are specifically issued to facilitate DOT's efforts to comply with the December 2, 2011 Presidential Memorandum entitled, *Implementation of Energy Savings Projects and Performance-Based Contracting for Energy Savings*.
2. The effective date of this delegation is July 11, 2012.

3. This authority may be re-delegated, and shall remain in effect until expressly rescinded. The Senior Procurement Executive (SPE) shall be notified in advance of any re-delegations of this authority.
4. The FAA will provide the SPE a summary of all contract actions related to this delegation on a quarterly basis. The first report is due October 1, 2012.
5. This memorandum rescinds all prior Department delegations of authority for this purpose, if any.
